Section 4 – First Aid Measures

Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.

Skin Contact: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. If rash develops, get medical advice.

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. If respiratory irritation occurs, seek medical attention.

Ingestion: Rinse mouth with water. Seek medical attention if feeling unwell.

Section 5 – Firefighting Measures

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Water spray, foam, CO₂, dry chemical.

Specific Hazards: Corn cob dust may form combustible dust-air mixtures.

Protective Equipment: Self-contained breathing apparatus for firefighting in confined areas.

Avoid creating dust.

Sweep or vacuum using explosion-proof equipment.

Prevent entry into drains or waterways.

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place.

Avoid breathing dust.

Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Exposure Limits: No established limit for mixture; treat nuisance dust per OSHA PEL for

particulates (15 mg/m³ total dust).

PPE: Safety glasses, gloves, dust mask if airborne dust may be generated.

Appearance: Light brown granular/ground material with mint odor

Odor: Minty

pH: Not applicable

Melting/Freezing Point: Not applicable

Flash Point: >60°C (peppermint oil component)

Solubility: Insoluble in water (solid base)

Bulk Density: ~0.3–0.5 g/cm³

Section 10 – Stability and Reactivity

Stable under normal use and storage conditions.

Avoid strong oxidizing agents and open flames.

Corn cob dust is combustible.

Section 11 – Toxicological Information

Peppermint oil: May cause skin sensitization and irritation.

Corn cob dust: May cause mechanical irritation to eyes and respiratory tract.

Section 12 – Ecological Information

Peppermint oil: Toxic to aquatic organisms with long lasting effects.

Corn cob is biodegradable.

Section 13 – Disposal Considerations

Dispose of in accordance with local, regional, national regulations.

Do not dispose of in waterways.

Not classified as dangerous goods for transport.
